criteria: 1) Returning teams, 2) Registered St. Aloysius Parishioners and 3)

General Public.

Contest Guidelines

Teams

The team captain is responsible for the conduct of their team

Teams are responsible for cleaning up their own areas

Each team is allowed 'kid cooks' for the hamburger patty competition

You will also receive Eight (8) complimentary passes for team members to enjoy the event

Each team will have approximately a 20'x20' area

Teams should bring their own tent, table and chairs

Water and power will be available, generators are acceptable. Power from the buildings will be reserved for low amperage items only – fans, TVs, etc. Coffee makers and griddles will need to have their own power supply.

You may enter as few or as many categories as desired

Each team must have samplings for 150 people sometime between 4:00 – 6:00

"Quiet Time" is from 11:00pm, Friday to 8:00am, Saturday

Please bring own grill, cooking utensils, coolers, ice, meat, seasoning, tents, etc.

St. Aloysius will provide eating utensils, serving plates for samples, gloves, napkins, wipes, chairs

Teams will be required to remain on site after results are announced in order to let the public leave the area. After site is deemed safe, trucks will be allowed into the area.

Meat may be prepared on any grill device (including propane, electric, etc)

Meat must be raw and unseasoned upon check-in on Friday Night (see schedule)

Refreshments for the cooks may be brought on site Friday night, or Saturday morning, but not during the general admission times (no glass containers)

Judging

We will have a mix of "Foodie" judges and celebrity judges

Judging will be based on (a) appearance, (b) taste and (c) tenderness

Teams should be prepared to serve 6 judges in each category

"Sides" and a "Dessert" category:

- a. Anyone can enter these categories (they do not have to be associated with a team)
- b. The entries can be prepared beforehand.
- c. Sides and Desserts can be used to supplement your "samplings" that you serve to our fellow parishioners.
