Extra-Ordinary Minister of Holy Communion Training

Before January 29, 2018, the deadline for preparing our next liturgical ministry schedule, **all current Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion** (those who serve at Mass and those who bring Holy Communion to the sick) **will be required to participate in a diocesan training session.** Bishop Muench has asked all Extra-Ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion in the Diocese to complete this video based training session produced by the Diocesan Office of Worship. Only those who complete this training will be included in the next liturgy schedule.

New people who wish to begin service must also participate in the diocesan training. In addition, they will need to meet with one of our coordinators for Eucharistic Ministers for a practical session about procedures unique to St. Aloysius Church.
